## Discovering: Jesus is Alive

In March, 1-3 year olds are learning to remember that Jesus is alive. The bread and juice at communion time remind us of Jesus. The empty grave and the empty cross remind us He is alive. Easter is a time to remember that He is alive!

## Discovering: The Lord's Prayer (Matthew 6:9-13)



## Table Talk

Start a discussion about greed. Look at how commercials, signs, and magazines tell us we'll be happier if we buy this or that or look like this or that.

Name the 7 deadly sins together. Then, add the opposites for each sin.

Instead of watching a show, watch the commercials. What is the message the advertiser is trying to communicate to you? What do they want you to do?

## Discovering: Disarming the Powers (John 10:10)

March in the Wonderground is in stark contrast to the Olympic frenzy of February. We spent February talking about how Jesus is King of All, so that in March we can focus on why He came - to disarm the powers of darkness. This is in tandem with the series the adult community is exploring. Our hope is that this leads to rich conversations at home.

We'll begin the month getting a glimpse of who God's enemy is - the accuser, thief, father of lies. Then, we'll move into how he uses the world, idols, sin, and death to discourage, confuse, and thwart the purposes God has for us. In April, we'll soak in how Jesus invites us into his way of life, life to the fullest.

We'll be showing Narnia clips throughout the month. Use spring break as a time to watch, read, or listen to *The Lion the Witch and the Wardrobe* or *The Voyage of Dawn Treader*. These movies will provide rich discussion!
